The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) and University Malaya's Centre of Poverty and Development Studies (CPDS - Faculty of Economics & Administration) cordially invite you to a public session on Rio +20 and the Green Economy: the Way Forward on 7th November 2012 (8.30am - 1pm). This is the opening session of a Green Growth E-Learning Workshop facilitated by UNESCAP and supported by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), the British High Commission, and University Malaya. While the workshop is only available to invited participants, the first morning session is open to the public and will be held at Dewan Kuliah 3, Faculty of Economics & Administration.
